## ● About Jeju Island

Jeju Island is Korea's largest island, celebrated for its unique culture, distinct sub-tropical climate, and stunning volcanic landscapes including Hallasan Mountain and lava tubes. It holds the prestigious UNESCO triple crown for its World Natural Heritage Site, Global Geopark, and Biosphere Reserve status, and was also named a New 7 Wonders of Nature. Relative geographic isolation has preserved a unique dialect and traditional lifestyle, exemplified by the Haenyeo women divers. As a significant tourist destination, the island is transforming to attract visitors and promote sustainable tourism.



## ● Visa-free Entry to Jeju Island

As a Self-Governing Province, Jeju may impose a different entry regulation from the mainland. In order to encourage visitors to Jeju Island, a visa-free entry policy has been imposed to assist foreigners who will be arriving in Jeju Island on direct flights from overseas without stopping over at any other parts of Korea.
